

## AEP Online Refresher course outline

### Course structure

AEP Online Refresher is the online version of the Adoption Education Program designed especially for previous adopters, foster parents, and others who have completed approved prior caregiver training. There are 7 modules in this 8-week course, with a new module opening up each week and staying open for 14 days. The modules open on Thursday mornings at 9:30 AM Pacific Time and close two weeks later on Wednesdays at 11:59 PM, allowing participants plenty of time to complete the coursework and assignments. Each module demands approximately 5 hours of work. There are 3 mandatory one-hour online live discussions during the course.

### Activities

The course is taught in a multi-media format and activities include:

- Reading articles
- Watching videos
- Listening to audios
- Watching presentations
- Offering written or audio journals
- Participating in online live group discussions
- Vocabulary building
- Answering questionnaires
- Taking quizzes

### Evaluation

You will be evaluated based on understanding and mastery of the material, your online engagement and participation, as well as your ability to demonstrate self-awareness and reflection.

### AEP-Online goals

To enable prospective adoptive parents to make realistic, well-informed decisions about their capacity and readiness to parent a child by adoption by providing education about core issues in adoption, as required by the Adoption Regulations.

Topic:	Introduction to trauma, the impact of trauma and triggers, responding to trauma

<b>Module 5</b>	<b>Child &amp; youth mental health issues</b>
Topics:	Introduction to child and youth mental health, common mental health issues, parenting strategies

Topics:	Learning about the adoption legislation, how children come into care, learning about permanency planning, legal rights & legal risks in adoption, post-adoption assistance
